New Implicit Bias Training Requirement

As of June 1st, 2022, the Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA) now requires all health care professions licensed or registered under the Michigan Public Health Code to take Implicit Bias Training.

The training must fulfill the following requirements:

- 1. Training must include strategies to reduce disparities in access to and delivery of health care services.
- 2. Training must include the administration of pre- and post-test implicit bias assessments.
- 3. The training must have a live component.

The required number of training hours is based off license renewal date.

New Applicants are required to have completed 2 hours of implicit bias training within the 5 years immediately preceding issuance of the license or registration.

Renewing licensees are required to complete 1 hour of implicit bias training for each year of their license or registration cycle. For initial renewal after June 1st, 2021, licensees will only need to have 1 hour of training for each year the new requirement was in effect.

Example:

Renewal Timeframe	Implicit Bias Educational Hours Needed
June 1st, 2021 – May 31st, 2022	None
June 1st, 2022 – May 31st, 2023	1 hour
June 1st, 2023 – May 31st, 2024	2 hours
June 1st, 2024 – May 31, 2025	3 hours
