Continuing Education Activity Application Tips

- Directly Provided Activities: Planning committee must be comprised of at least two-thirds WMed faculty and/or staff
- Jointly Provided Activities: Planning committee includes less than two-thirds or no WMed faculty and/or staff
- Applications should be submitted at least 90 days prior to the start date of the activity
 - Course applications will not be accepted within 60 days of the start date
 - RSS applications will not be accepted within 45 days of the start date

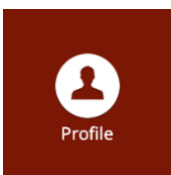
Half-Year Evaluation Summaries

 Reminders from the CE Office

Learner Credit Data Upload Starting July 1!

Starting July 1, 2023, WMed's Office of Continuing Education will be uploading learner credit data to Joint Accreditation's Program and Activity Reporting System (JA PARS). Learner credit data entered in JA PARS will be reported to the participating state medical licensing boards and certifying boards in collaboration with the ACCME, eliminating the need for physicians to track and submit their credits to these boards manually.



For WMed's Office of Continuing Education to upload learner credit data, we need participants to update their profile.
