Human trafficking – you might know what this is, but do you know what to do if you encounter this in the clinical setting? This 4-hour event will include information about human trafficking's intersection with health care and focus on the provider's application in the clinical setting. Participants will use what they learn in lecture to improve their skills during real time cases in WMed's simulation center. Attendees will practice recognizing human trafficking, safe intervention, and the use of resources to aid patients being trafficked. The simulation includes three cases, with two involving patients being trafficked so participants must learn to identify trafficking correctly.
