RSS Rolling Calendar Year Start and End Dates

WMed CE is pleased to announce a new flexibility in our application process. Based on Accreditation Standards, feedback from coordinators and directors, and recent reporting changes, we are now equipped to accommodate rolling-calendar year applications. This means you can now submit applications that reflect your program's actual start and end dates, even if they do not align with the traditional January through December calendar year. RSS Evaluation Changes

You spoke, we listened! Now, for activities that qualify, we are making available a twice-a-year evaluation option for participants. This would be different than the per-session or per-child evaluation option that is currently standard across all RSS activities. Those eligible activities would be ones that would not require speaker evaluation nor session-specific objectives feedback. So, committees, journal clubs, tumor boards, etc... MOC for ABIM


